- “Discretionary powers of the Cassation Court”,
- “Programs of School of Advocates”,
- “Constitutional legitimacy and legitimacy of order of enforcement proceedings concerning charging operations of administrative penalties without judicial act”,
- “Discretionary powers and transparency of the Council of Justice”, “Legitimacy of applying in regard to physical persons of concentration regime by the RA Economic Competition Commission”,
- “Detention as preventive measure and sustenance of detainees”,
- “Limitation of access of advocates to the penitentiary territories in non-working hours and days”.

RA Minister of Justice highlighting the importance of working behavior to solve the issues in the healthy way of discussion, arranged a separate meeting with the chairman of the RA Chamber of Advocates in the near future in the RA Chamber of Advocates and discuss the mentioned issued in detail.
