CCBE CONDEMNED THE VIOLENCE AGAINST ADOCATES AND CALLED ON THE PRESIDENT OF RA

In addition, the CCBE wishes to recall that all lawyers should be able to carry out their professional duties without fear of reprisal, hindrance, intimidation or harassment in order to preserve the independence and integrity of the administration of justice and the rule of law.
